The CASA SERRA FOUNDATION presents the ninth edition of Scholarships 2024, an activity that began in July 2014.

It is an EXCHANGE SERVICE FOR NEW GENERATIONS University students and other young adults between 18 and 30 years old can enjoy short-term exchanges. On our campus promoted by the Casa Serra Foundation and the Rotary Clubs of Mallorca, in addition to promoting mutual knowledge and international friendship, you will learn about current Mallorca and the life and work of Saint Junípero Serra in America.

We have available 8 (eight) two-week scholarships in Mallorca, 4 (four) for Mexican students 4 (four) for students from the United States, from June 16 to June 30, 2024, It is essential in this 2024 edition: Be a student or recent graduate of: Magisterium,(Teaching) Ibero-American Language and Literature Hispanic Culture, History. Another UNIVERSITY STUDY Knowledge of the Spanish language is necessary. The stay will be in Petra (father Serra's hometown), and in Palma de Mallorca.

With the collaboration of the Rotary Clubs of Mallorca, the Scholarships awarded by the CASA SERRA FOUNDATION will include:

- Stay at the Petra and Palma Residence.
- Institutional breakfasts and meals.
- Petra–Palma–Petra train transport voucher.

Not included: Round trip travel from your usual residence.

Health or civil liability insurance that must be subscribed.

Meals in free time and personal expenses, which must be assumed by the interested parties or by the Rotary Clubs or Universities that endorse them.

Study or computer material.

To qualify, applicants should be above-average students who have demonstrated leadership in their community. Candidates should also possess qualities such as flexibility and a willingness to try new things that will enable them to fully experience life in another country. The program is completely managed by Rotary club members, which keeps personal program expenses low.

Students and their parents or sponsors are generally expected to cover the following expenses: potlucks, side trip money, and private tours. Round trip ticket, Travel insurance that includes medical, accident and illness coverage. Health and civil liability insurance that must be subscribed. It is mandatory to follow current public health regulations during your stay in Mallorca.

Our commitment is extended only from Sunday June 16 to Sunday June 30. We can advise on possible trips for Spain or Europe before or after these dates under his cost and responsibility.

We would like you to forward this project to others Rotary Club of your local area or collaborators. We request to your club the diffusion of this scholarship and the presentation for as much candidates as you can: at least two-four candidates. You should support his good conduct and disposition to fulfill the habitual procedure in RI's exchanges.
